

WHO IS CCBO? ▼

CCBO is the **only** organization dedicated to continuing education for community college business officers.

Members will find valuable resources that help them implement gainful funding initiatives and increase collaboration among college boards and executives to continually grow campus-wide resources that drive student success, recruitment, and retention.

CCBO is the voice of Business Officers on AACC's Affiliated Council.

The American Association of Community Colleges (AACC) is the primary advocacy organization for the nation's community colleges. The association represents nearly 1,200 2-year, associate degree-granting institutions and more than 12 million students.

AACC Affiliated Councils are non-profit organizations that are determined by AACC to be committed to advancing the role of community colleges in serving society consistent with the policies and priorities of the AACC. This service is done through providing specialized services or engaging in activities for or in support of community colleges.

Affiliation is granted for a 5-year period, subject to renewal by the AACC Board of Directors upon the recommendation of the AACC Executive Committee.

Awards

You work hard to bring success to your campus. Honor members of the profession by nominating yourself or a colleague for a CCBO award.

CCBO has four award categories plus an award specifically intended to spotlight institutional excellence.

Bob Hassmiller Award for Humanitarian Service

The Bob Hassmiller Award for Humanitarian Service is given to an individual who best exemplifies an exemplary service mindset. The recipient will display the core principles of humanitarianism including: (1) a desire to bring assistance without discrimination, (2) ensures respect for their fellow human beings, and (3) promotes mutual understanding, cooperation, and friendship.

The Outstanding Business Officer and the Outstanding Chief Business Officer Awards honor those individuals with distinguished service to their institution and community.

Outstanding Chief Business Officer Award

In a single campus setting, acts as the Chief Financial Officer for the institution and is a senior member of the executive team, reporting directly to the President. In a multi-campus setting, acts as the Chief Financial Officer for the entire organization and is a senior member of the executive team, reporting directly to the President or Chancellor.

Outstanding Business Officer Award

Any employee in the line of authority under the Chief Business Officer of the institution

Exemplary Practice Award

The Exemplary Practice Awards recognize outstanding, innovative or collaborative practices in areas such as Human Resources, Finance, Technology, Facilities, and others.

Emerging Professional Award

The Darrell E. Roberts Emerging Professional Award is an award that identifies a future leader in higher education- someone possessing high potential to advance to leadership roles in positions of greater authority and responsibility in the field of higher education business, finance, and administration.

Leadership Academy

The Academy provides an opportunity for current and aspiring community college business officers to educate themselves on the various intricacies of Chief Business Officer leadership. The Academy's goal is to provide participants with the knowledge of the theories and practice of leadership within a community college as an institution of higher education.

Tuition: \$1500 (includes 2 years and annual conference registration)

2020 Dates: October 17-18, 2020 Leadership Academy

The knowledge and learning shared in this program is the ONLY educational source geared directly FOR community college business officers, by community college business officers targeted FOR community colleges.

The cost is reasonable, the return outstanding. Your future and the future of your institution makes this a critically important decision with a truly positive return on investment that will pay over your career lifetime.

The Academy is designed to train the next generation of Chief Business Officers and to provide current leaders with updated information on national issues facing community colleges.

The Leadership Academy occurs two days prior to the CCBO Annual Conference. All students are expected to attend the CCBO Annual Conference following the Academy sessions and take advantage of other learning opportunities as well. This same timeline will occur for the subsequent year.

The Academy is open to all potential and current leaders. Applicants should have a background in some area of community college administration; however, consideration will be given to those who do not have any administrative experience. Academy participants do not need to be CCBO members to participate.

The program is designed to span one year, beginning and ending with the CCBO Annual International Conferences. Participants can receive up to 20 CPE hours split between two conferences. Attendees participate and are immersed in discussions and activities related to leadership skills, current community college issues, and relevant topics. Please note there is a mid-year project that all participants are required to complete.
