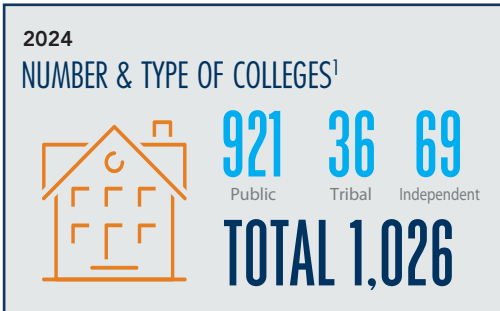

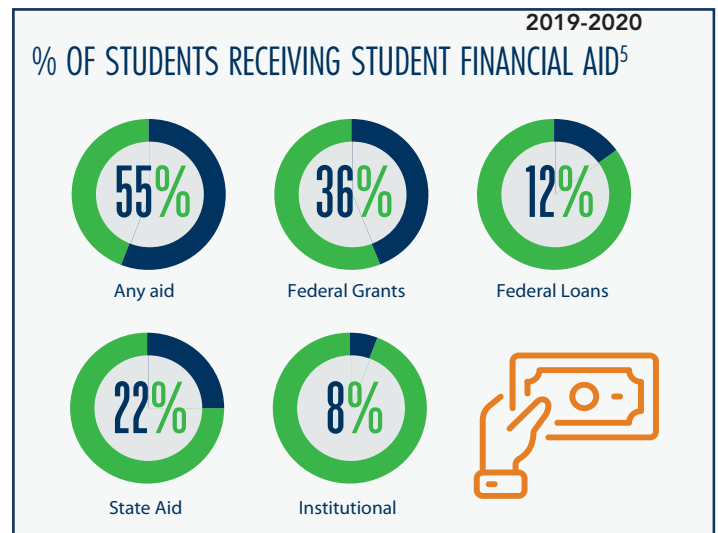
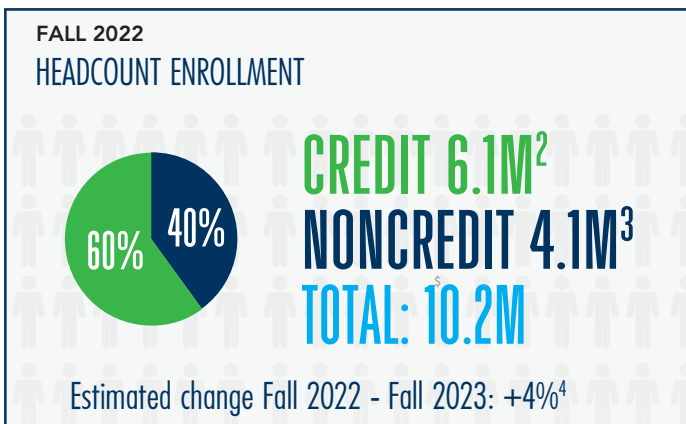
Why Join?
